Your Support Helps Us

The Sister Mary Philippa Health Center

The Sister Mary Philippa Health Center (SMPHC) was opened in 1923 as a clinic for the sick and needy. For nearly 100 years, the clinic has stood as a cornerstone of St. Mary's mission to care for our community's underserved and most vulnerable populations. Yearly, 1,800 patients see primary care physicians and specialists for routine and critical medical care. Our highly-trained physicians, interns, residents, nurses, and staff serve those from diverse ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds, regardless of their ability to pay.

The SMPHC provides annual physicals, acute care, and chronic disease management in areas such as

oncology, cardiology, gastroenterology, general surgery, optometry, orthopedics, psychiatry, podiatry, pulmonary, urgent care, and urology. St. Mary's proudly opened one of the first dedicated HIV clinics in 1986, and continues to provide integrated care for people living with HIV in San Francisco.

In addition, the clinic offers certified diabetes education, cooking classes, social services, medical legal services and an on-site pharmacy. There are weekly peer groups for emotional support for patients with chronic diseases. Food and transportation coupons are an essential means of helping patients cope with food insecurity and essential transportation to



and from clinic appointments.

As part of the Dignity Health Initiative against Human Trafficking, the Sister Mary Philippa Health Center hopes to launch medical and social services for victims by becoming a medical safe haven by 2022.

McAuley Behavioral Health Institute - Providing Emotional Health for Young People

The McAuley Behavioral Health Institute of St. Mary's Medical Center (SMMC) is one of the few dedicated Adolescent Inpatient and Outpatient Programs in the Bay Area serving 11-17 year-old teens and their families. The average length of stay could be from three (3) days or at times up to ninety (90) days for inpatients. <u>St. Mary's currently holds</u> the only inpatient adolescent behavioral health license in San Francisco serving over 3,500 patients each year from across the Bay Area and California.

The program helps patients manage psychiatric crises by providing education, alternative coping strategies, and resources they and their families can utilize. The program provides individual and family therapy, milieu therapy, medication evaluation and education, as well as psycho-education. Our team consists of registered nurses, mental health clinicians, licensed social workers, a milieu therapist, mental health technicians, nurse practitioners and psychiatrists who work hand in hand to provide the best care for our patients.



Through a partnership with the San Francisco School District, teens attend school and graduate from McAuley while also receiving therapy.
